In view of recent events our response and commitment as a body of faith to stand by others in need: We will continue to do outreach to all houses of faith in hopes of positive engagement in line with the Mission Statement of the Faith Subcommittee with the goal of ending homelessness in Ventura. Pam will send out an email blast to as many houses of faith as possible in February to remind everyone of City's meeting in March regarding zoning changes for a shelter/bridge housing with services, plus an additional reminder in March.
- 2. Winter Warming Shelter updates using Oxnard National Guard Armory. Need training dates (Steve Karnazes) and online link for donations (Kevin Clerici) Judy will contact.
- 3. Regarding zoning changes in Ventura and year-round shelter with services updates: City's Task Force meeting: Beginning a list of guidelines and a list of possible locations. The Chamber of Commerce is on board with this. There is a need to identify possible operators, locations, and funding information to give to Council in March.
