# Purpose of Report

- This slide deck provides a high-level demographic snapshot of the City of Ventura. It is intended to explore key trends, characteristics, and potential issues that merit further review and consideration in the City's forthcoming General Plan Update. For reference, this slide deck also includes data at the State and County levels to contextualize the City's characteristics in relations to broader conditions.

# Summary of Key Findings

- Although Ventura's population declined between 2015 and 2020, growth is expected to rebound and continue into the coming decades.
- Ventura is an aging community, as the share of people 55 and older has climbed substantially since 2000 (21% → 33%).
- Ventura hosts a well-educated population. Almost half (45.9%) of all adults have an Associate's Degree or higher, which is higher than the County (43.1%) level.
- Like the State as a whole, Ventura has become more racially and ethnically diverse over the past two decades. The share of the Hispanic/Latino residents has increased 19.7% since 2000, now forming 36.0% of the City's population.

# Summary of Key Findings

- The distribution of household income in Ventura is very similar to County and State levels, though Ventura hosts a relatively higher share of low-income households (43.9%) than does the County (40.0%).
- The Westside and Downtown areas host the highest concentrations of poverty and low-income households.
- Over the past 10 years, Ventura's jobs/housing ratio has steadily increased. This suggests that housing production may not be keeping pace with economic growth, which can cause high commuting rates and potentially increase living costs.



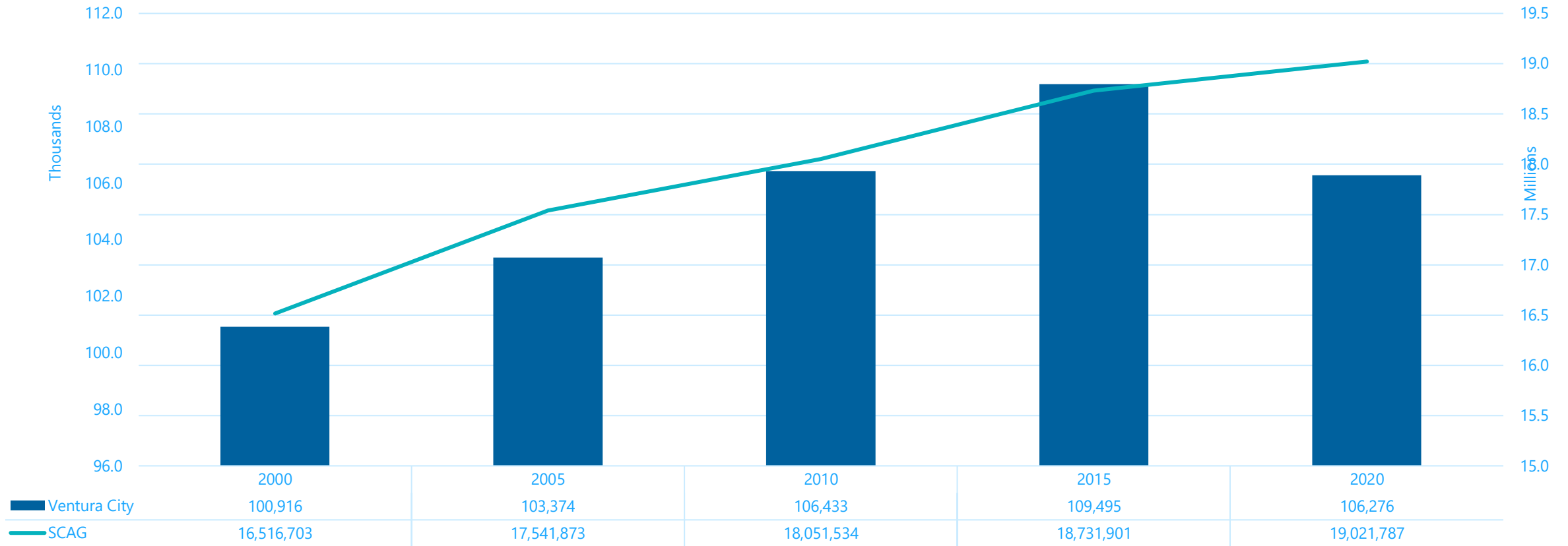

Figure 1: Population, 2000-2020

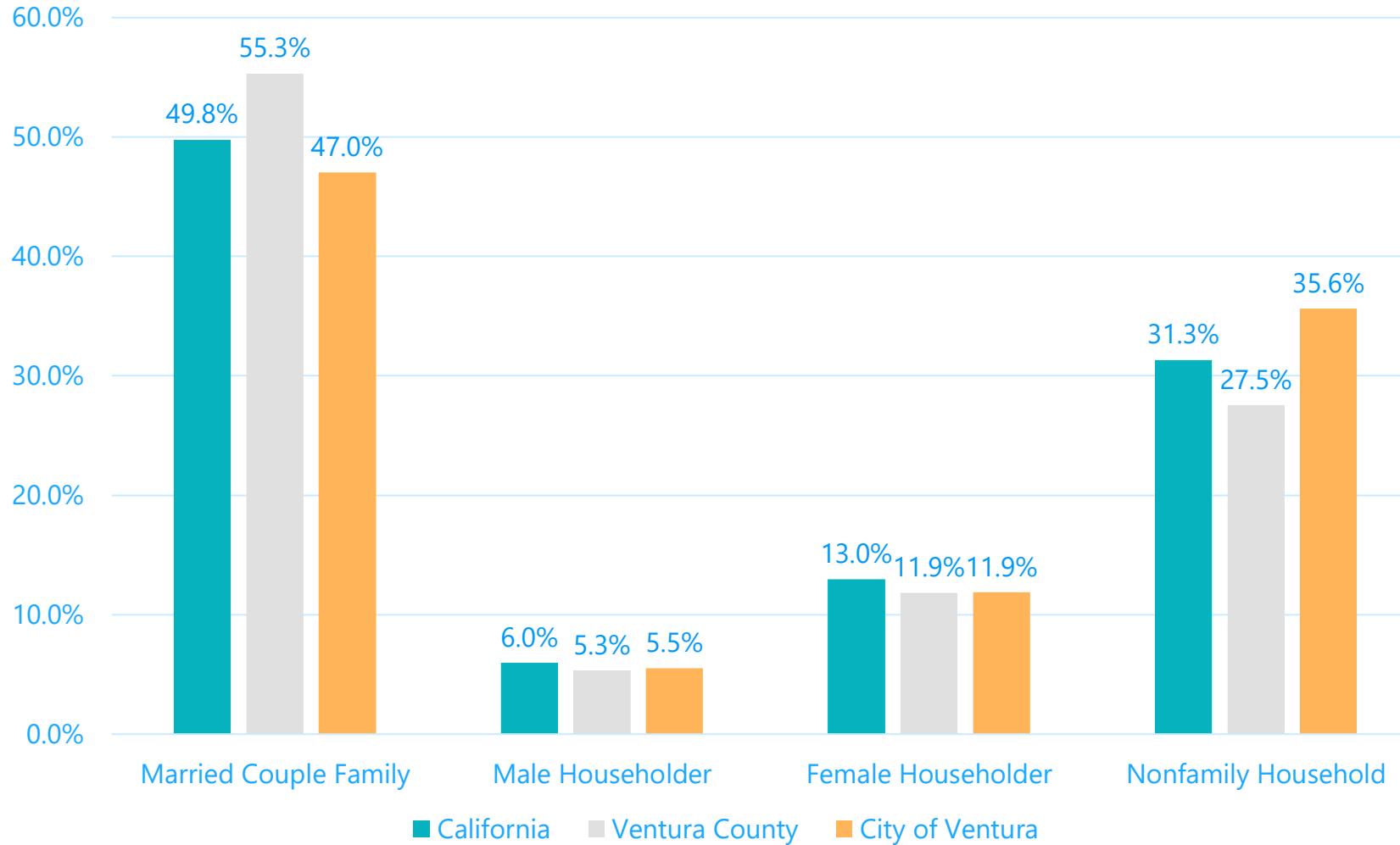

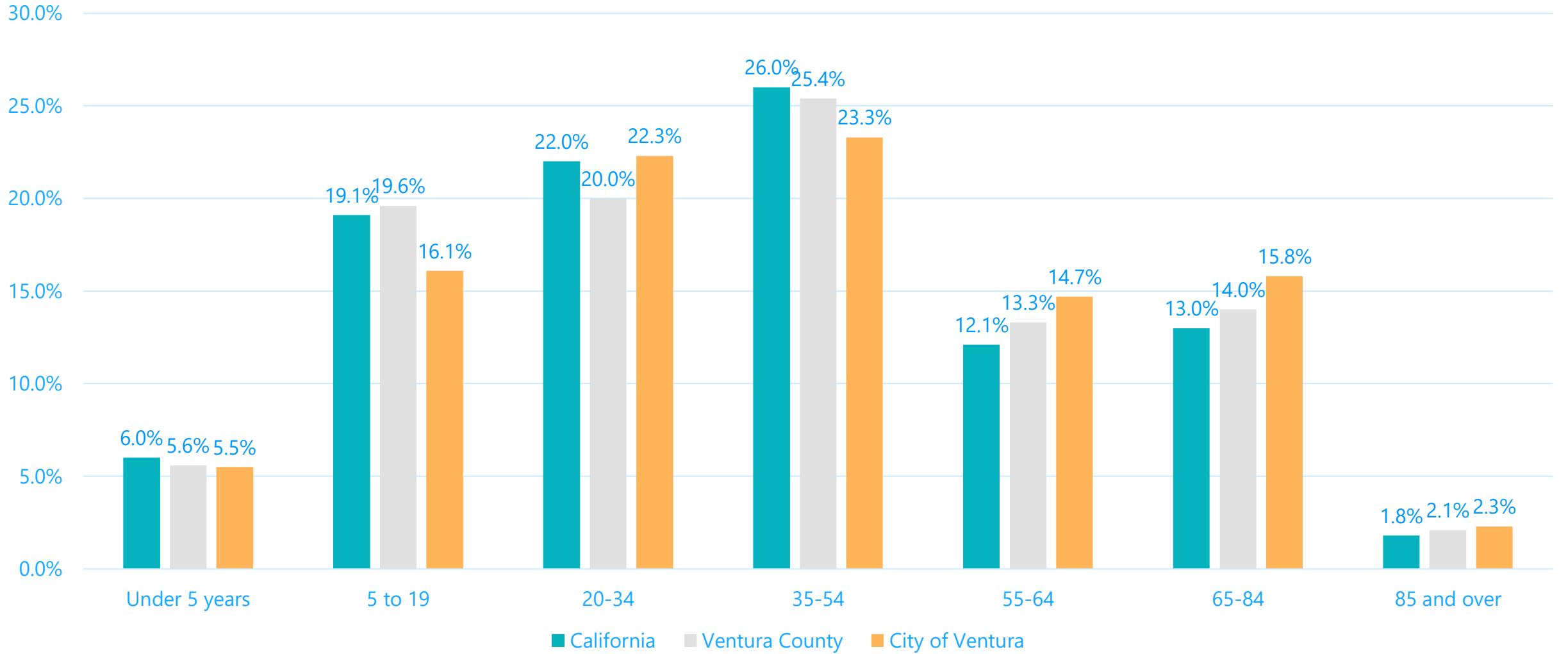

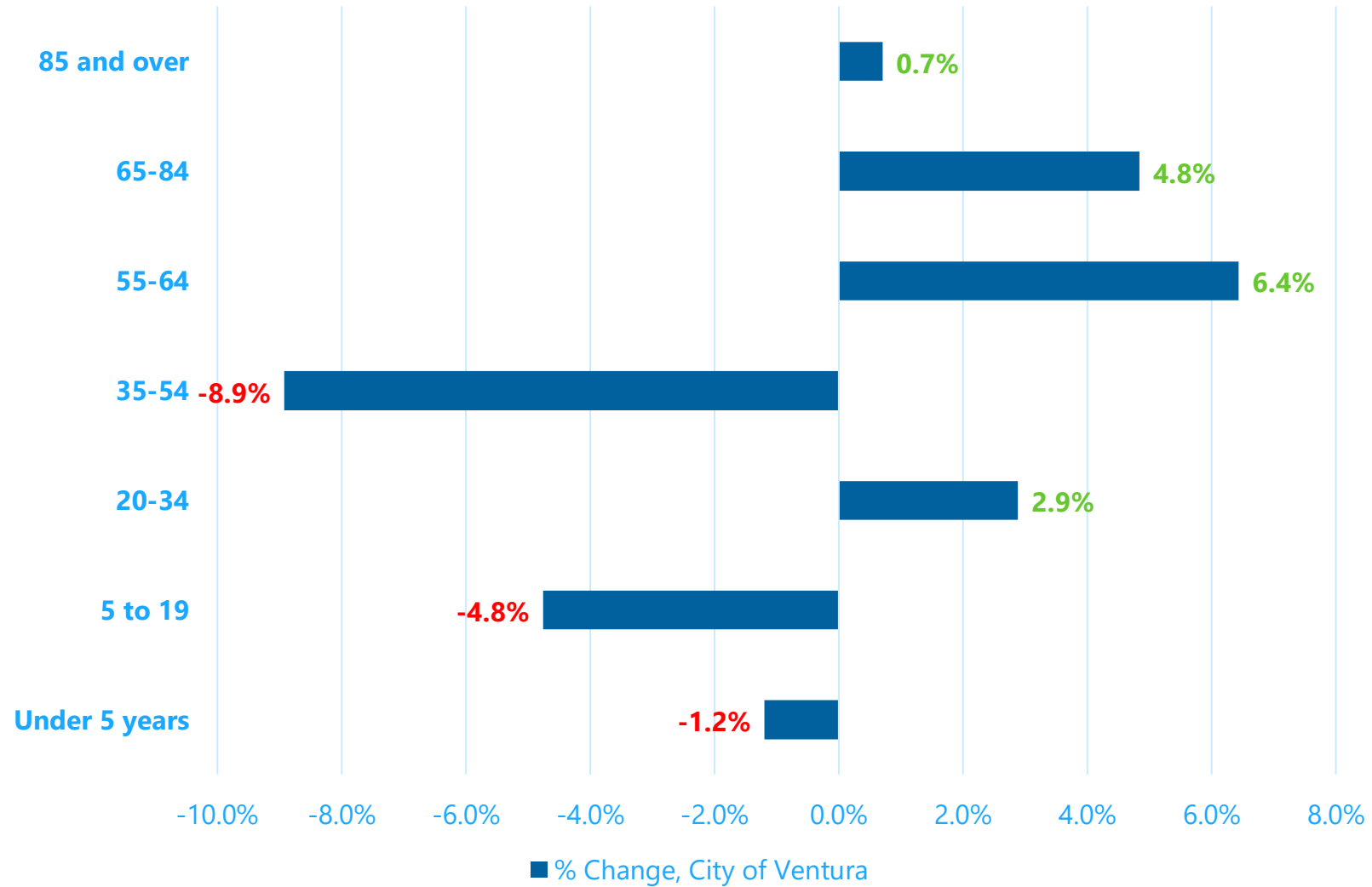

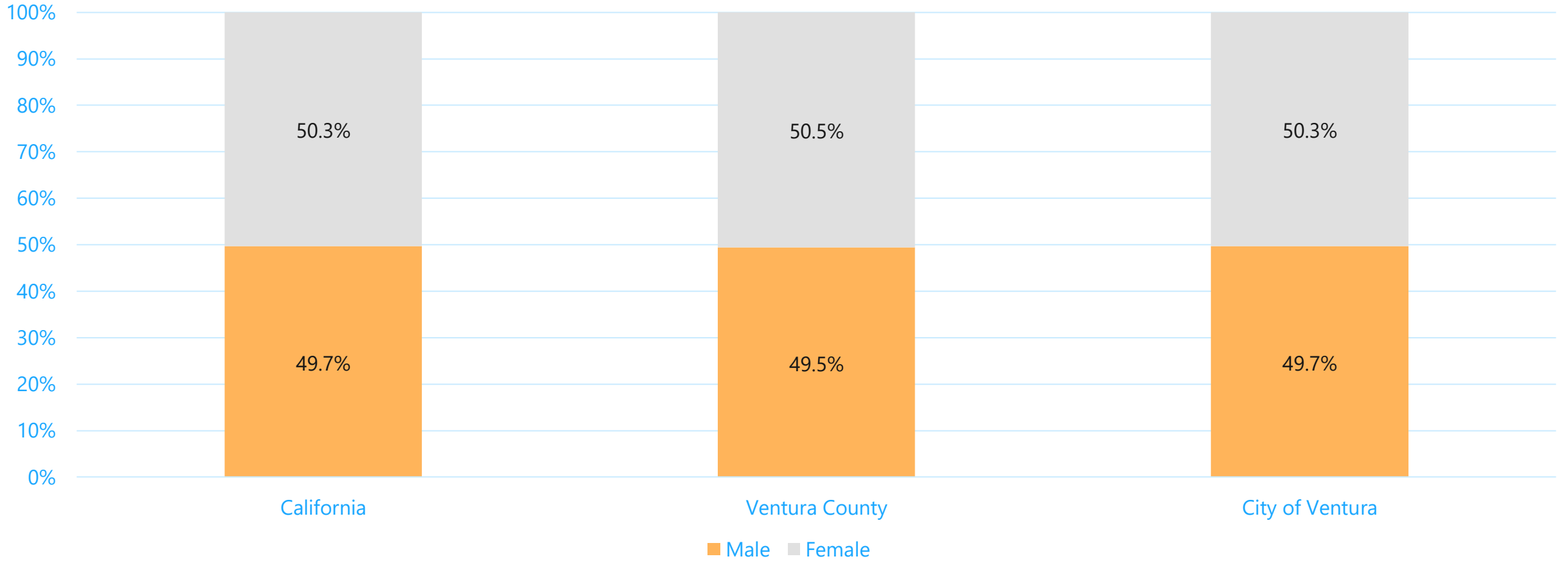

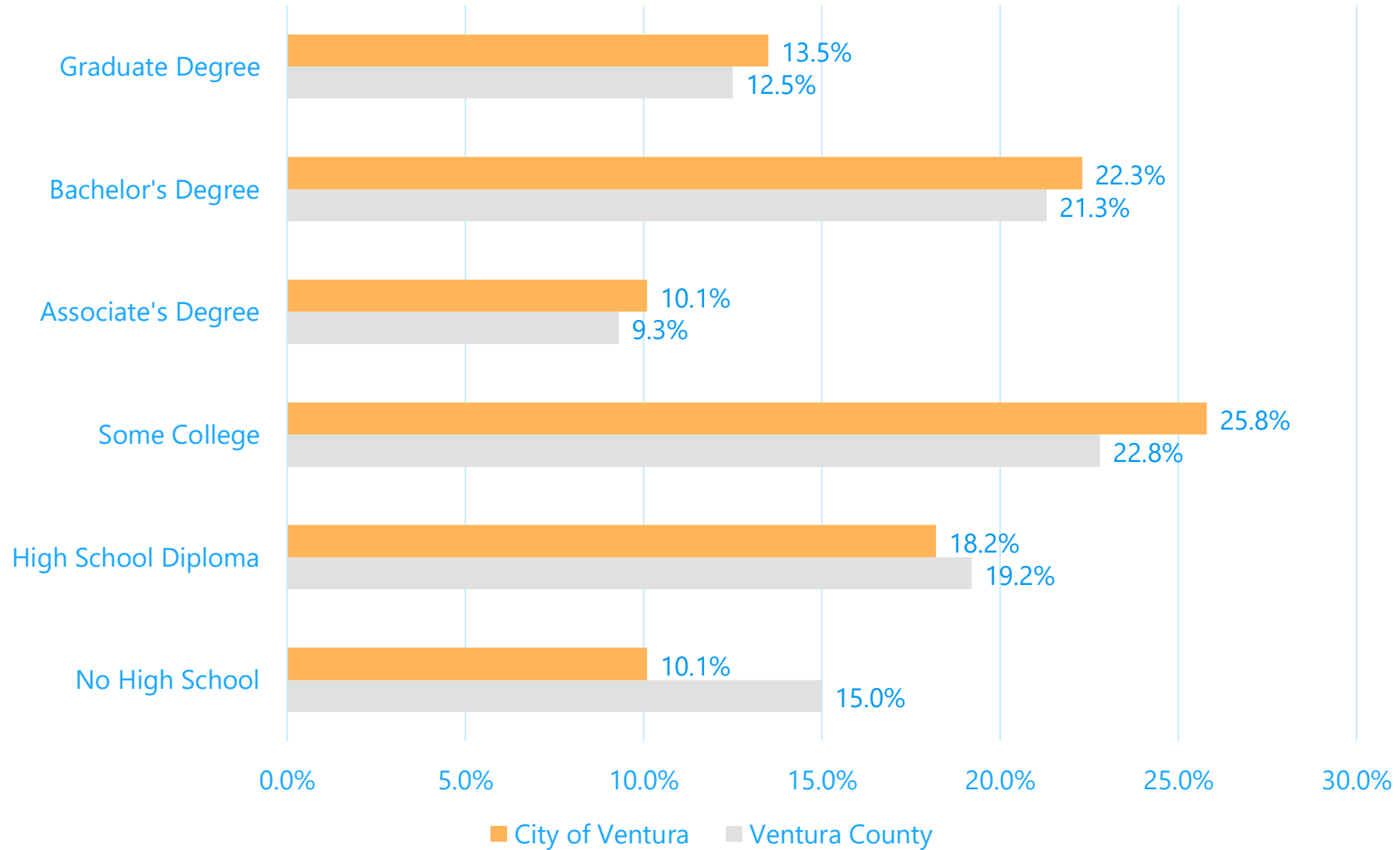
# Age: 2000 – 2019



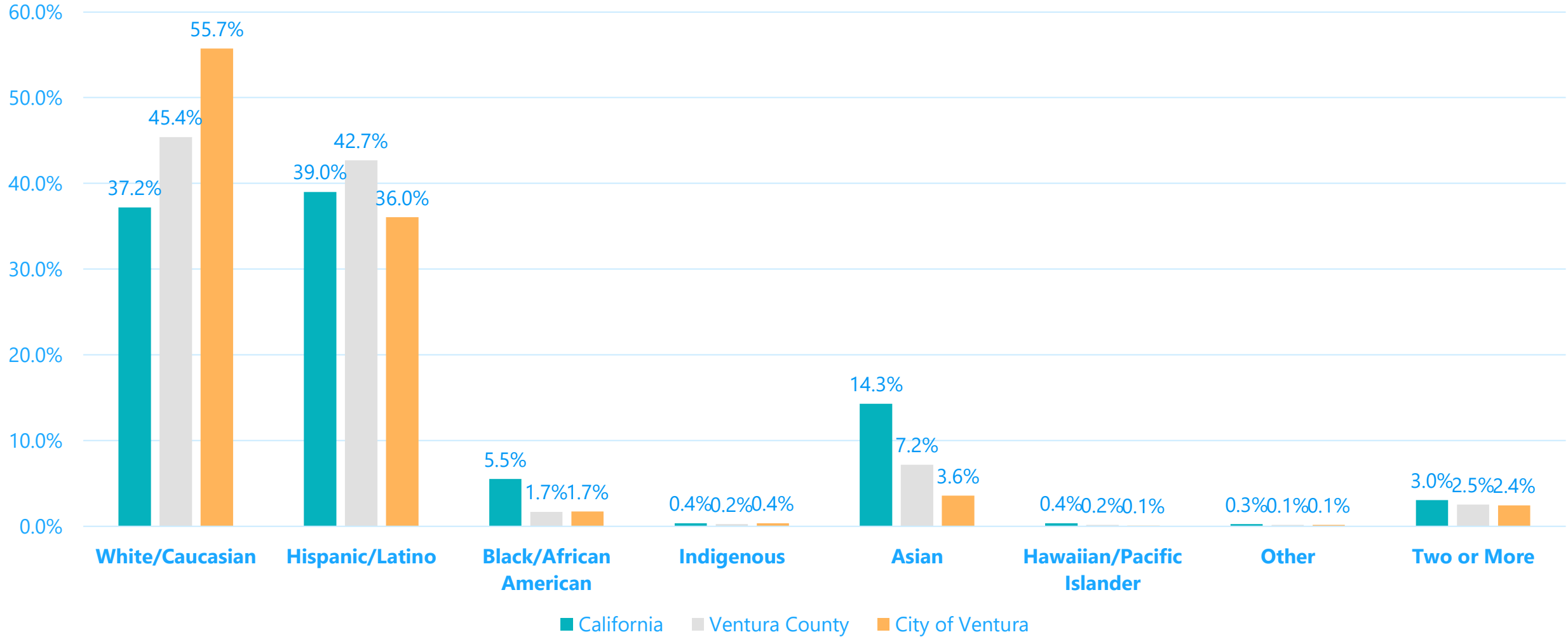

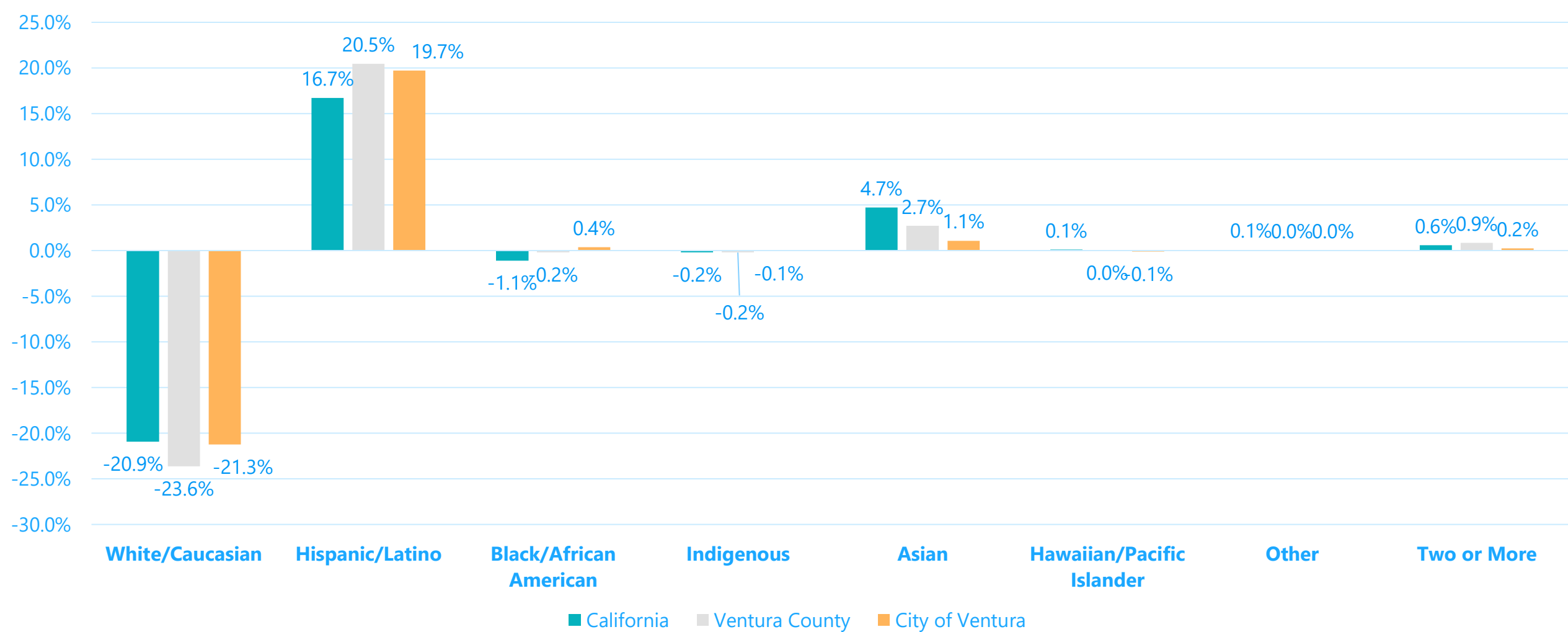

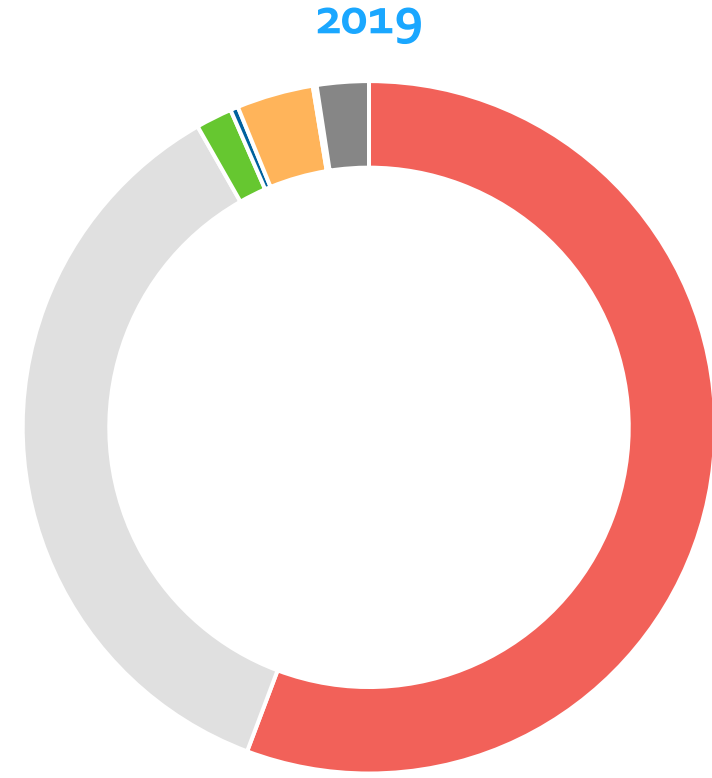
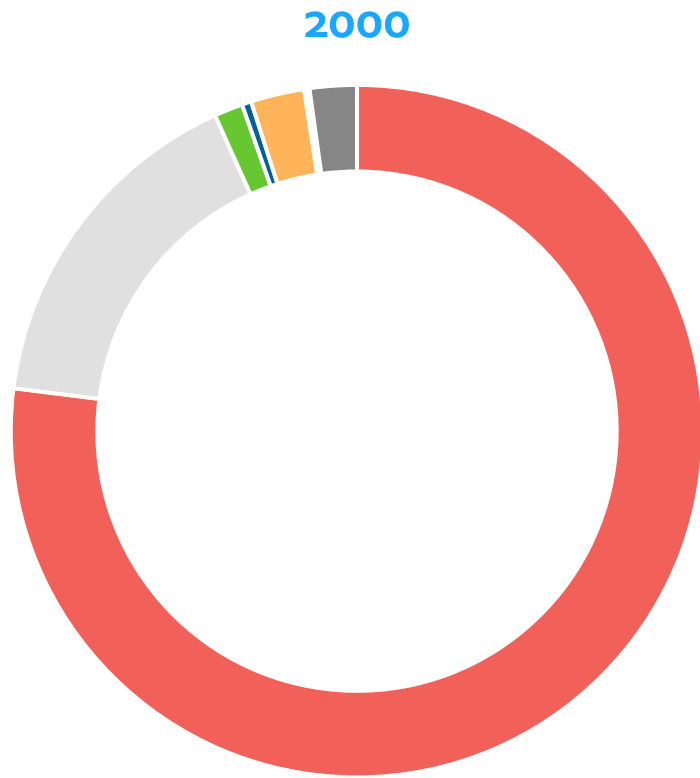

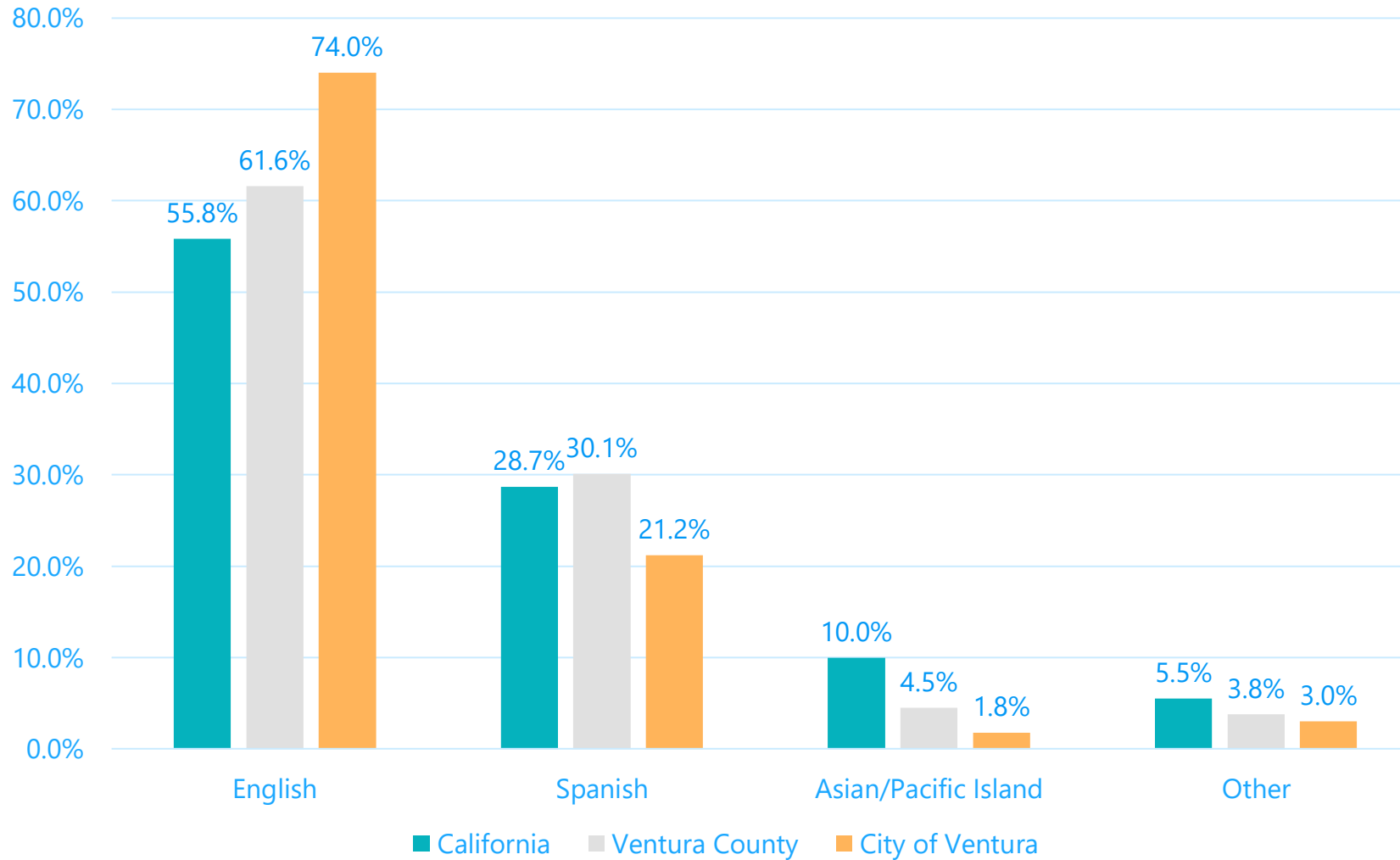

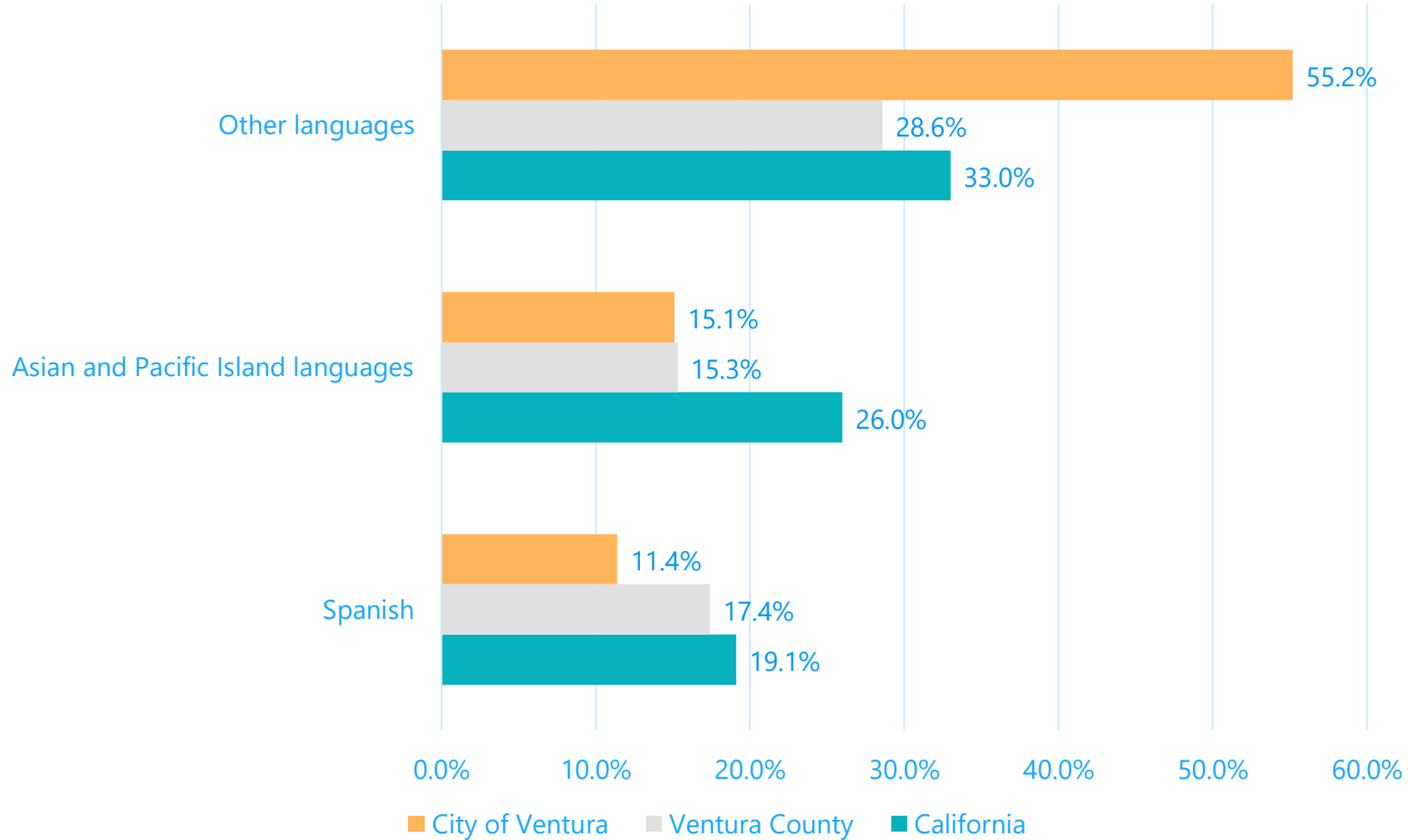


# Language Spoken at Home

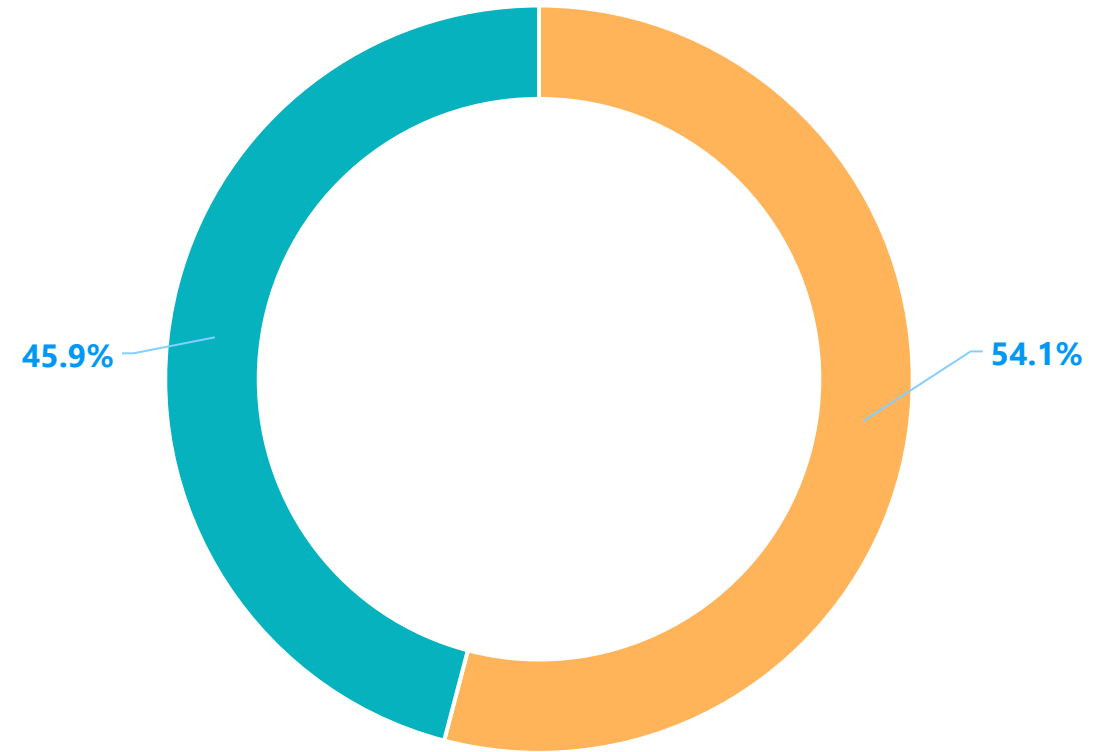
# Housing Tenure

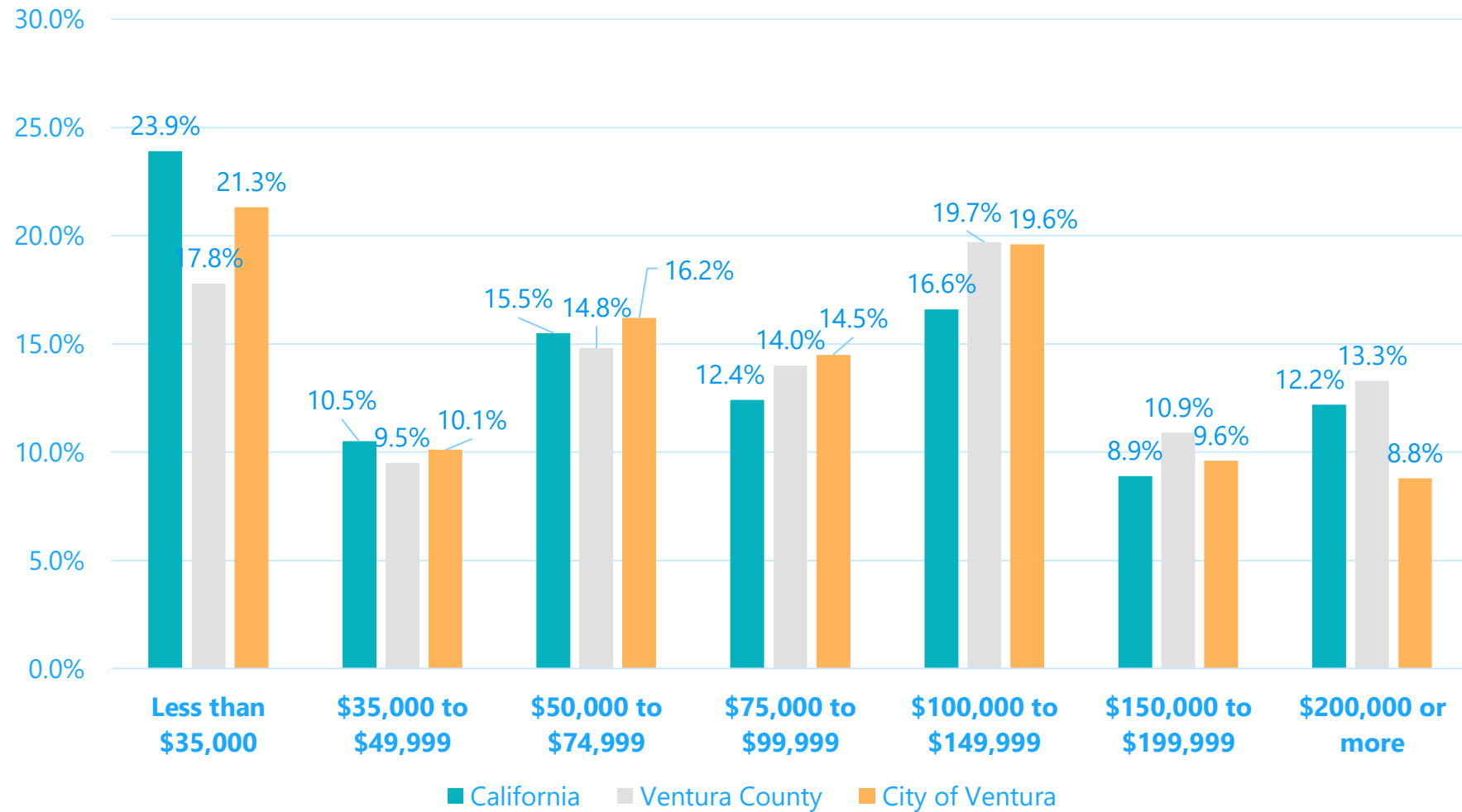

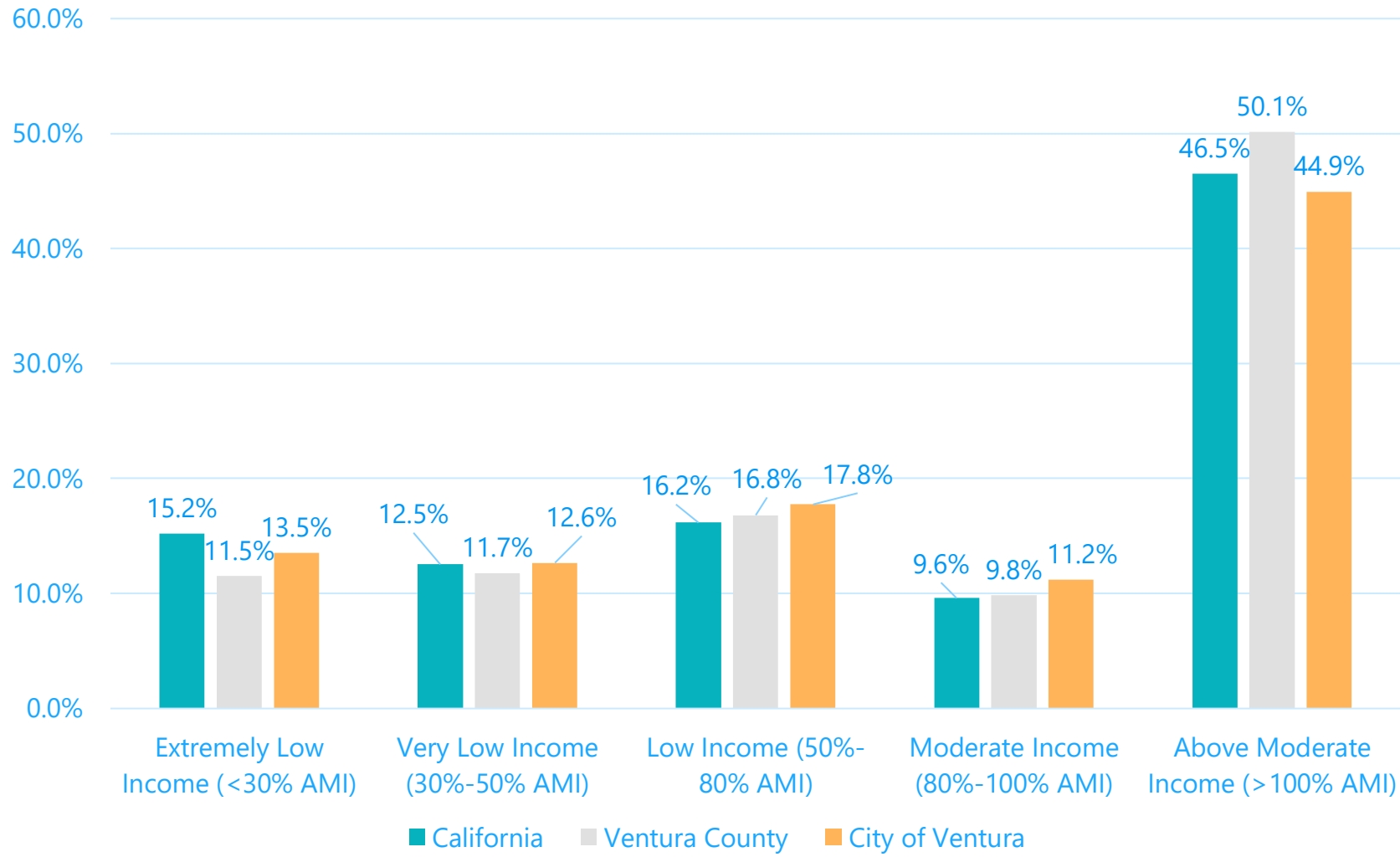
