

VENTURA COUNTY HOUSING SURVEY

PURPOSE

In partnership with CSUCI, HOME is conducting a survey of Ventura County residents about their current housing situation, needs and future expectations. Survey data will be analyzed, presented at the 2024 Ventura County Housing Conference on October 24th, and used to advocate for building the types of housing our community needs.

PROCESS

Any person living in Ventura County, 16 years of age or older, regardless of housing situation or dependency status, is urged to complete this short survey. Answers will remain anonymous.

The survey is available in both English and Spanish, accessible by QR-code or web link.

In appreciation for completing the survey, several \$50 Amazon gift cards will be awarded. To enter the drawing, click on the link in the thank you email, and enter both name and email address. The first round of gift cards will be distributed in early June. Only one entry per person please.

Please urge co-workers, neighbors, friends, and family to complete the survey. With greater participation, data accuracy and conclusions are improved.

Data will be analyzed by CSUCI students in the Economics department, with results summarized and presented at the 2024 Ventura County Housing Conference on October 24th in Camarillo. Survey data, results and conclusions will be available to the general public after the conference.

Depending on the sample size collected, this project may continue beyond October 2024.
